Eligibility

The exhibition is open to all residents of Chatham-Kent. A maximum of 1 work may be submitted. A completed Submissions Form must accompany all submissions. All media accepted. All works must be original and completed within the last two years. The submitted artwork MUST relate to the theme of the exhibition. ARTspace reserves curatorial discretion and the right to refuse any submissions not relating to the theme or if your application is incomplete. If your work is for sale: a commission of 40% will be collected by ARTspace on all sold art. Please factor commission rates into the sale price.

Hanging

All works must be ready for display. Two-dimensional works must be suitably framed and wired. Works requiring special installation must be accompanied by explanatory diagrams or photographs.

Sales

ARTspace will collect a commission of 40% on all sales. Please factor commission rates into the sale price. For the gallery to be able to issue payments, you will need to complete a New Vendor Form, which the gallery will provide you after a sale has occurred.
