## Eligibility

The exhibition is open to all Chatham-Kent artists. All media accepted. All works must be original and completed within the last two years. A maximum of three works may be submitted by each artist. All works must be for sale and include sale price.

## Jurying

Artwork must be delivered for jurying to the Thames Art Gallery, 75 William St. N. Chatham (Murray Street entrance) October 19-22 between 11:00 am - 4:00 pm.

### Juror

Scott Everingham holds a BFA from NSCAD University in Halifax, and an MFA from the University of Waterloo. He is a 3-time RBC Canadian Painting Competition Finalist with exhibitions at The Power Plant, the National Gallery of Canada, and the Musée d'art contemporain de Montréal. He is the recipient of numerous awards including the Jon Imber Painting Award from the Vermont Studio Centre, and from Canada, Ontario, and Toronto Arts Councils. He has work in the collections of the Art Gallery of Nova Scotia, BMO, CIBC, and RBC Collections, and was recently exhibited in New York, Los Angeles, and London. Everingham lives and works in Toronto.

## Administrative Fee

A non-refundable handling fee of \$35.00 for up to three works must accompany the application form. Only cash, debit or credit accepted.

## Hanging

All works must be ready for display. Two dimensional works must be suitably framed and wired. Works requiring special installation must be accompanied by explanatory diagrams or photographs.

#### Sales

A commission of 30% will be collected by the Thames Art Gallery on all sales. Include commission in sale price.

### **Transportation and Insurance**

All shipping arrangements and costs before and after selection are the responsibility of the submitting artist. The Thames Art Gallery will not accept any collect shipments. All works will be insured by the Cultural Centre while on the premises.

#### **Awards**

A total of \$2000 will be presented: Three Awards of Excellence - \$500 each. One People's Choice award - \$500.

#### November 18

Opening Reception, Awards, Brush Off, and Auction. Doors open at 6:00 pm. Exhibition open to view until January 14, 2023.

#### November 23-26

Artwork not accepted can be picked up between 11:00 am - 4:00 pm. TAG will not be responsible for any uncollected works after December 7, 2022.

The artist, by submission of entry, grants the Thames Art Gallery the right to photograph accepted work for publicity, educational and reference purposes. No entry may be withdrawn once it has been accepted.
